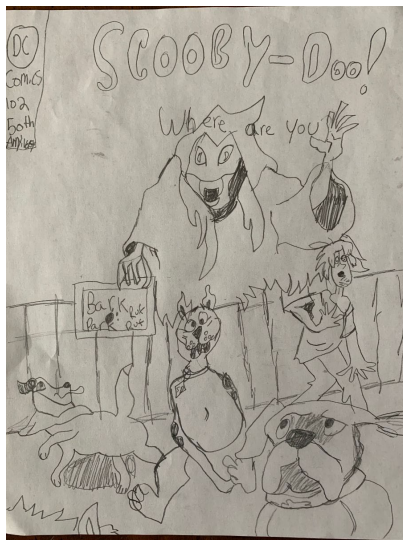
We wanted to have a place where we kids could do something together without being in the same place. **This is our first issue and it is AWESOME SAUCE!**
