Mr. Hertel

Per your request relating to a complaint you received on a pesticide application made by our company. Please find attached a copy of our application record for Fishkill Rd. in Putnum County for 2017. I also copied the County on this email, for their record.

The application was on behalf of Putnum County thereby not requiring a Commercial Lawn Contract. It was for bare ground control of all vegetation within the right of way under and behind guiderails and around the bases of all sign posts.

Herbicide used was a tank mix of a nonselective glyphosate product applied to all specified areas. Additionally, Dupont OUST XP (old stock) was injected into the spray stream when appropriate. The injected mix is turned on when the sprayed areas meet the water setback requirements.

Because of the nature of this complaint I thought it might be helpful to include a couple pics of the equipment used. We used a truck mounted spray tank with fixed nozzles equipped with anti-drip check valves. Nozzles are sized to provide a fixed and course spray pattern to reduce drift. A spray computer system is used to maintain proper rate regardless of vehicle speed and to control injected material into the spray pattern. The operator manually activates the spray nozzles and injection with cab mounted switches and the computer controls rate based on vehicle speed and programed application information.

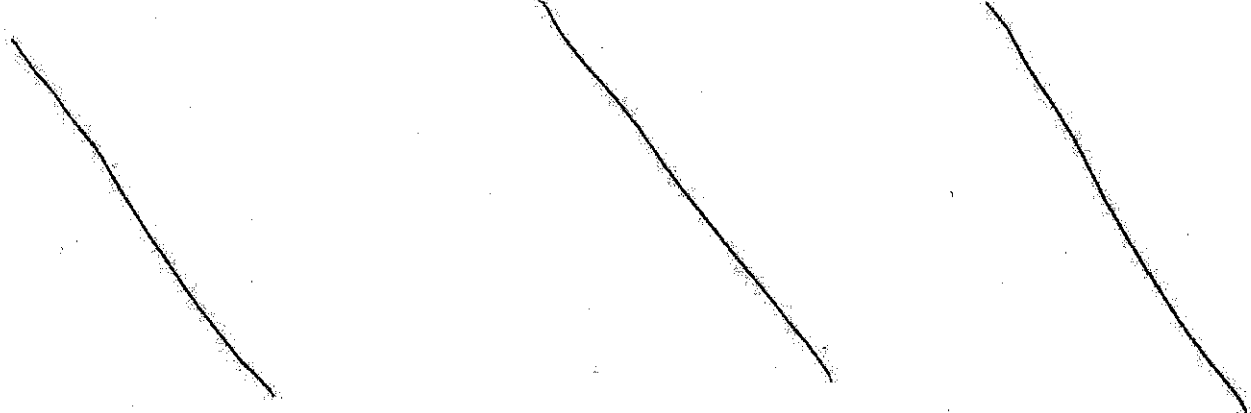

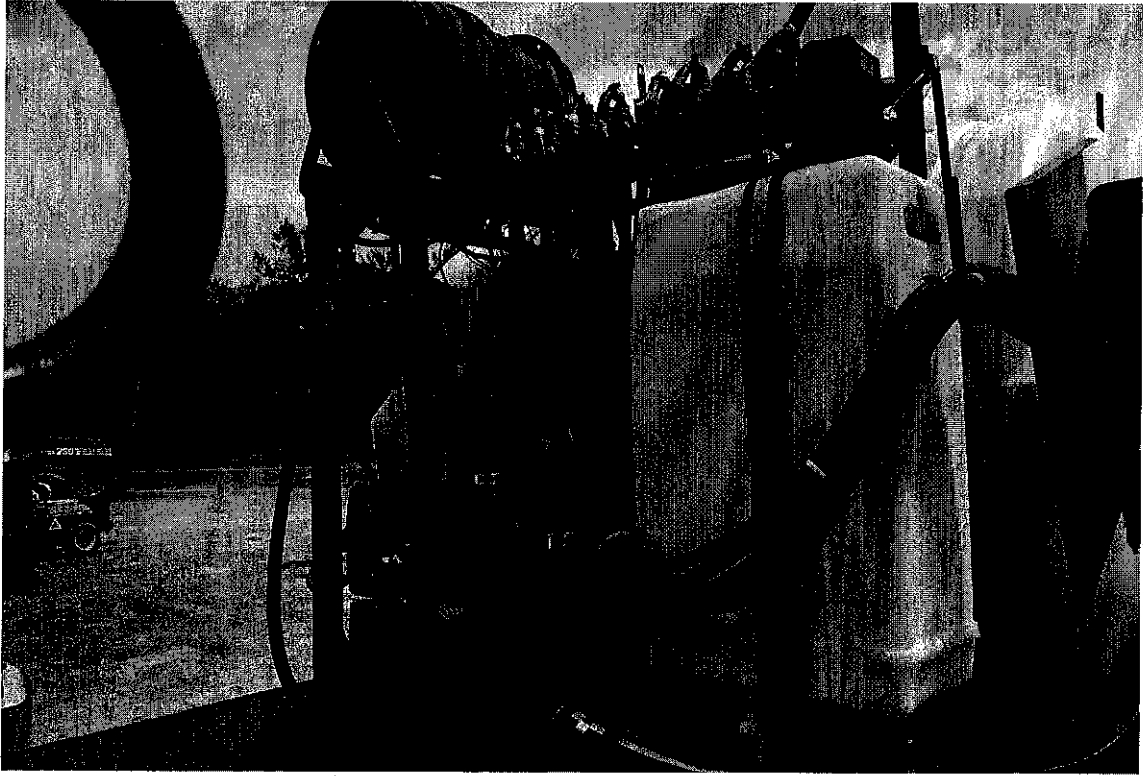
