- 2.) Mustbe a child or legal dependent of an active retired or deceased U.S. military service member whose family resides at West Point or within a 35-mile radius of West Point at the time scholarship is awarded (June 2020). Student must posess a current dependent ID card
- 3.) Scholarships will not be awarded to applicants who accept an appointment to one of the service academies and their affiliated preparatory schools, any ROTC scholarship award, any overseas programs, special programs, fully funded programs or an applicant who has received any other full scholarships at an accredited U.S. post-secondary institution of higher education.
- 4.) Minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA or higher

- **1.)** Scholarships are designated to pay for tuition, books, and fees for degree programs at accredited institutions of higher learning.
- 2.) DUSA Scholarships Chair will notify the scholarship winner directly by MAIL and EMAIL. <u>Check</u> your email and mail often!
- 3.) Funds are dispersed in Fall 2020 after the scholarship winner provides bursar information and registration information. Please submit outside Scholarship Financial Aid office Address, telephone number, and proof of enrollment by Ocober 1, 2020.
